

State Prone and Benchrest Championships – 2017 **Devil's Gate Rifle Range, Sheffield**

Match No. 1	Short Range (20 metres) Championship 60 shots prone / Bench Rest 20 metres	Saturday 28th October 8:30am
Match No. 2	Long Range (90 metres) Championship 60 shots prone / Bench Rest 90 metres	Saturday 28th October 12.00 mid day
Match No. 3	Dual Range Championship Combined 20 and 90 metres. Bench Rest combined 20 and 90 metres	Saturday 28th October
Match No. 4	English Match (50 metres) 60 shots prone / Bench Rest 50 metres	Sunday 29th October 9:30 am

Only financial members of the T.S.A.R.A. or equivalent mainland State Associations are eligible to compete. Juniors are any competitor under the age of 21 years at the commencement of the competition.

Visiting interstate competitors *MUST produce a list of their last eight 50 metre scores*, signed by a club official, or **they shall be automatically placed in 'A' Grade.**

Awards:

Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded for the first three in the PRONE OPEN competitions, along with the perpetual trophies for Short Range, Dual Range, English Match open, and Ladies and Junior English Match. There will be an award for the first junior in the English Match.

A graded competition (A, B and C) will be run in conjunction with each *prone* open match and placegetters will be presented with gold, silver and bronze medals (subject to there being sufficient entries in each grade).

Benchrest *will not* be graded (as we do not have sufficient competitors entering at this point in time). Championship medals (gold, silver and bronze) will be awarded for the 2-day aggregate (20, 90 and 50 metres). Minor medals will be awarded for 1st place in each of the individual events, i.e. Short Range, Long Range, Dual Range, and 50 metre (2nd and 3rd will be awarded if we have sufficient entries).

There are Perpetual Trophies for the Benchrest Dual Range Championship and 50 metre championship.

Fees:

Matches 1, 2 and 4 are \$15 each. Competitors entering Matches 1 and 2 will automatically qualify for Match 3 without need for further payment. No extra payment will be required by Juniors however these competitors should indicate their eligibility when entering.
