## DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE CHARTER

A TRA Development Committee consisting of nominated persons and a TRA Board Member as the Chairman shall be established to promote and encourage greater numbers of shooters to participate Small Bore and Air Rifle shooting.

The TRA Board member shall be the Development Committee's representative to the TRA Board.

The Development Committee shall present, via the nominated Board Member, at least one annual written report with recommendations to the Board, and attend to any other matters that may be referred to the Development Committee by the TRA Board.

The role of this committee shall be as follows:

- The Committee's primary objective is to encourage more people to shoot more regularly by enabling
  - More first time shooters having a go and taking up the sport.
  - More existing shooters enjoying the sport more often.
  - More non shooting members enjoying the sport sometimes.
- to place before the board of TRA Ltd. Researched, costed and, if necessary, funded proposals that are designed to increase shooting numbers and interest in the sport;
- to provide any resource materials to State Associations and clubs that can used to promote our sport;
- to provide direction and leadership in breaking new ground to broaden the appeal and increase awareness of Smallbore and Air rifle shooting; and
- to investigate alternate structures and possibly events that can be undertaken by our members whilst remaining within the existing ethos of the sport.
