ELEY ammo helps secure 100% Olympic Quotas at the Oceania Games

100% Olympic Quota places for athletes using ELEY ammunition at the Oceania Shooting Federation Continental Championships, Australia.

The Australian team dominated with Golds and Olympic Quota places in nearly every .22LR discipline at the Oceania Shooting Federation Continental Championships - securing 6 out 7 of the Quota places on offer. The final Olympic Quota place for .22LR events went to New Zealand who were also shooting with ELEY ammunition.

In the Men's 50m 3 Positions event 16 out of 18 athletes in the qualification were using ELEY tenex to help them get into the final but it was three Australian shooters who made it to the podium and medalled.

Dane Sampson, who shot batch tested ELEY tenex to win the Gold in style in the Men's 3 Positions final with a total score of 444.8, will now be representing his country at the Olympic Games in Rio 2016.

The competition was close and Dane's fellow teammates were hot on his heels throughout, but he consistently won each round and shot a 10.3 in the final standing elimination shot. In the end William Godward using ELEY tenex won Silver with 440.6 and Daniel Clopatofsky won Bronze with 427.5.

The Australian team didn't stop at one Quota place or even at a full podium. Emma Woodroofe in the Women's 50m Rifle 3 Positions final also shot exceptionally well throughout the competition and with ELEY tenex won the final with 434.9 securing an Olympic Quota place.

The team showed their dominance again with a full podium in the Women's 25m Pistol final with all three medal winners using ELEY tenex pistol. Elena Galiabovitch won Gold and another Olympic Quota place in this competition, and following close behind was Linda Ryan who took Silver and Lalita Yauhleuskaya who took Bronze.

A further three other Olympic Quota places were won by Australian athletes using ELEY ammunition: in the 50m Rifle Prone Men's final Frederyk Woodhouse scooped a place using ELEY tenex, David J Chapman in the 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Men's final using ELEY match OSP won a further Quota, and Daniel Repacholi using ELEY tenex in the Men's 50m Pistol final won the Gold, also securing himself an Olympic Quota place.

Australian coach Petr Kurka must be very happy with these results... we wonder what his secret is!
