

Target Rifle Australia Limited Bench Rest Committee Charter

The TRA Bench Rest Committee consisting of up to four nominated persons and a TRA Board Member as the Chairman, shall be established to provide recommendations to the TRA Board concerning all matters relating to Small Bore and Air Rifle Bench Rest shooting disciplines.

The TRA Board member shall be the Bench Rest Committee's representative to the TRA Board.

The principle objective of the Bench Rest Committee shall be to promote, develop and encourage greater numbers of participants in Small Bore and Air Rifle Bench Rest shooting disciplines.

The Bench Rest Committee shall present, via the nominated Board Member, at least one annual written report with recommendations to the Board, and attend to any other matters that may be referred to the Bench Rest Committee by the TRA Board.

The role of this committee shall be as follows:

- To liaise with the TRA Technical and Competition Committee to formulate and update technical rules for the Bench Rest disciplines within TRA as required
- To liaise with the TRA Competition Committee to formulate and update competition rules for the Bench Rest disciplines within TRA as required
- To place before the board of TRA Ltd. researched, costed and, if necessary, funded proposals that are designed to promote, develop and increase shooting numbers and interest in the sport
- Provide any resource materials to State Associations and clubs that can used to promote the Bench Rest Disciplines of the sport.
- Provide direction and leadership in breaking new ground to broaden the appeal and increase awareness of Smallbore and Air rifle shooting.
- Investigate alternate structures and possibly events that can be undertaken by our members whilst remaining within the existing ethos of the sport.
