COACHING COMMITTEE CHARTER

A TRA Coaching Committee consisting of nominated persons and a TRA Board Member, shall be established to co-ordinate the education and development of coaches within TRA; and to support and engage coaches in their coaching activity with TRA members, from Club to AISL pathway.

The TRA Board member shall be the coaching representative to the TRA Board.

The Coaching Committee shall present, via the nominated Board Member, at least one annual written report with recommendations to the Board, and attend to any other matters that may be referred to the Coaching committee by the TRA Board.

The role of this Committee shall be as follows:

PART A - THE EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF COACHES

- i) To ensure the standard and uniformity of Coach Education Courses conducted under the AISL Accreditation Scheme;
- ii) To review and update Coach Education support material as required;
- iii) Encourage participation by States in these accreditation programmes;
- iv) To co-ordinate national coaching and/or athlete seminars.

PART B - SUPPORT AND ENGAGE COACHES AND ATHLETES

- i) To co-ordinate the coaching needs of athletes under TRA programmes;
- ii) Engage, train and support local, State and National mentor coaches;
- iii) Coach training / programmes being inclusive and broad in the involvement with athletes;
- iv) Develop the delivery infrastructure of coaching across Australia;
- v) Develop the connections between coaches via various means
