## TECHNICAL COMMITTEE CHARTER

A TRA Technical Committee consisting of up to five nominated persons and a TRA Board Member as the Chairman, shall be established to co-ordinate the rules of the different disciplines; to educate and develop Range Officials within TRA; and to support Range Officials in their activities from Club to National Level.

The TRA Board member shall be the Technical Committee's representative to the TRA Board.

The Technical Committee shall present, via the nominated Board Member, at least one annual written report with recommendations to the Board, and attend to any other matters that may be referred to the Technical Committee by the TRA Board.

The role of this committee shall be as follows:

- To formulate and update rules for the various disciplines within TRA as necessary from time to time;
- To ensure uniform application of the rules by means of common thought in training and in application of the rules;
- To develop a National Official's training course, examinations and approve the issue of TRA Range Official's Licenses;
- To co-ordinate and help Officials with accreditation and training;
- To encourage and support Officials from Club level through to National level, and to pass onto International level;
- To create and maintain a database of TRA accredited and ISSF accredited Range Officials;
- The Chairman of the Technical Committee shall recommend to the board of TRA a technical Delegate for the National Championships.
