Role of Club Instructor
To introduce visitors and new members to the sport of target shooting.

Role of Club Coach
To assist members in the club to improve their shooting skills, and to provide information on the athlete pathway.

Role of the Competition Coach
To assist motivated F3 level athletes to improve into the T areas.

To support the ongoing development and improvement of F3, T and state based athletes.

To mentor, support and educate Club Coaches.

Role of the Advanced Coach
To support the ongoing development of state and national (T to E/M) athletes

To support, mentor and educate state and club coaches and to take a role in the Athlete Pathway Framework.
