#### Policy and Procedure - TRA Record Score.

- 1. Australian Records will only be recognised when shot by Australian Residents.
- 2. Australian Records may be set in the following competitions:
  - The Olympic Games
  - ISSF and WRABF World Championships
  - ISSF and WRABF World Cups
  - The Commonwealth Games
  - The Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships
  - The Regional Championships of the Oceania Federation
  - Australian National Championships
  - State or Territory Championships
  - Shooting Australia Endorsed Performance Series Events.
  - · Any other international competition recognised by the ISSF or WRABF
- 3. For a new record that is established, a certificate shall be issued to the new record holder. In the event that more than one competitor breaks the existing record, at the same match, at the same venue, with equal scores, then each shall be issued with a certificate.
- 4. A new record will be recognised from the production of results by Results Information Systems (RIS), signed by the appointed senior technical official for the competition. The accompanying sheet listing those records must also be signed and attached to the results bulletin and received by email within 4 working days of the competition.
- 5. One "Claim for Verification of TRA Record Score" form is required to accompany a complete list of results for the event(s) and is to be forwarded to the TRA Executive Officer.
- For a record score claimed at TRA National Championship events, the TRA senior technical official must ensure that the Classification Jury has rechecked all targets relating to record scores. Targets, printer ribbons or individual result printouts are to be retained by the Host State for a period of thirty (30) days.
- 7. For a record score claimed at other competitions where records can be established, as per clause 2, the results of that competition for confirmation of records as well as a source for verification of those results (e.g., contact details for the organising committee or a world wide web hyperlink to a published results list) should be forwarded to the TRA Executive Officer for verification.
- 8. Once verified the TRA Executive Officer will update the TRA records accordingly, notify the athletes concerned and organise for the updated records to be uploaded to the TRA website.
