Only financial members of the T.S.A.R.A. or equivalent mainland State Associations are eligible to compete. Juniors are any competitor under the age of 21 years at the commencement of the competition. Visiting interstate competitors (*prone and benchrest*) **MUST produce a list of their last eight 50 metre scores**, signed by a club official, or they chall be automatically placed in W Grade. (**TSAPA Prone Form Grading is:** "A" FZF+, "B" FEF to FZ4 9

club official, or they shall be automatically placed in 'A' Grade. (TSARA Prone 50m Grading is: "A" 575+, "B" 555 to 574.9, "C" 554.9 and below.)

Awards:

For the four matches (Short Range, Long Range, Dual Range and 50 metre) Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded, for the first three in the OPEN in **both** the PRONE and BENCHREST competitions. There will be the traditional PRONE perpetual trophies for open Short Range, Dual Range, English Match, Ladies and Junior English Match. There will be an award for the first junior in the English Match. There will be the traditional BENCHREST perpetual trophies for open Dual Range and 50 metre championships.

A **"graded"** competition (A, B and C) will be run in conjunction with both the prone and benchrest matches. (Matches 1, 2, 3, and 4). Place getters will be presented with **certificates** for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd (subject to there being *sufficient* entries).

Fees:

Matches 1, 2 and 4 are \$15 each. Competitors entering Matches 1 and 2 will automatically qualify for Match 3, without need for further payment. No extra payment will be required by juniors, however these competitors, should indicate their eligibility when entering.
