### AIR GUN TOUR 2025 MATILDA EYLANDER





For the 2025 Air Rifle Tour, we traveled to Austria for the Meyton Cup and Germany for the H&N Cup, an amazing opportunity to grow as athletes. Experiencing international competition at this level was invaluable, allowing us to compete against top shooters in a high-performance environment. Everyone on the team learned and gained so much from this trip. It was an incredible experience, and we're all so grateful for the opportunity to grow and learn on the international stage.



### AIR GUN TOUR 2025 RESULTS

During the first Junior Women's Air Rifle competition at the Meyton Cup in Innsbruck, Charlotte finished qualifications in first place with a score of 626.8. She then went on to shoot the finals where she finished in third.

Matilda Eylander just narrowly missed the finals with a score of 621.1 placing her in 11th and Angie Wang just 0.1 behind in 12. In 25th place Emily Cane scored 614.9. And for their first international competitions Jadelyn Young finished with a 608.2 in 38th and Darcee Young with 603.6 in 40th! The Air Rifle Junior Men shot after the women, with James Cane just missing the finals in 9th place with 616.4 and Lucas Li placed 18th with 606.9 for his first international competitions competition also!

On day 3 of the Meyton Cup the Australian Junior Rifle Team competed in another Junior 10m Air Rifle Competition. Congratulations to James Cane on qualifying for the finals in 8th place in the Junior Men's with a score of 616.2 and finishing in 8th place in finals ! In the same match Lucas Li placed 12th with 611.6. In the Junior Women's competition Charlotte Bland just missed out on the finals with a score of 621.1 placing her in 9th, Angie Wang shot a 617.8 placing her in 14th shortly followed by Emily Cane in 16th with 616.8 and only 0.2 behind was Matilda Eylander in 17th ! In 21st place Darcee Young shot a 614.7 and Jadelyn Young in 33rd shooting a score of 606.6!

On day 1 of the H&N Cup Jack Rossiter competed in the 10m Air Rifle Men Qualification placing 36th with a score of 625.4. He followed this up on day 2 finishing in 15th with a score of 629.9, with the cut off for the finals being an impressive 631.1! On Day 3 the Air Rifle mixed teams event occurred, Australia had 3 teams entered, team 1 was Jack Rossiter and Charlotte Bland and team 2 was Angie Wang and James Cane and 3 was Lucas Li and Matilda Eylander. With a score totalling to 629.6 Jack and Charlotte placed 9th, with 615.3 Angie and James placed 62nd and in 65th Matilda and Lucas scored a total of 612.9.



### AIR GUN TOUR 2025 RESULTS

Ending the Meyton Cup was the Junior Air Rifle competitions! On Day 4 both the junior men and women competed. In the junior men's, James Cane placed 40th with a score of 620.0 and Lucas Li in 69th with 606.1! In the junior women's Charlotte scored 622.7 placing 53rd followed by Matilda Eylander in 75th with 618.5, then Emily Cane with a score of 618.2 in 78th, then Angie Wang in 97th with 613.8, immediately followed by Jadelyn Young 1.1 behind, then Darcee Young scored 605.2 to place 101st. On the last day in the junior men competition, James Cane placed 37th with a total of 620.7 and Lucas Li in 71st with 598.9! In the junior women in 42nd Charlotte shot a score of 624.1, then Emily Cane in 64th with 620.1, followed by Matilda Eylander with 619.3 in 72nd, Angie Wang in 79th with 618.2, In 92nd Jadelyn Young scored 613.6 and Darcee Young placing 104th with a score of 602.9! We congratulate all the juniors on all their hard work and dedication throughout their time away and wish them all the best for the upcoming competitions!
